



10th Annual Attleboro Expo for the Senses

Craft Fair & Art Sale

The City of Attleboro will present its 10th Annual Expo for the Senses, on Saturday, August 18th, 2018. This family-friendly, outdoor event will be held from noon to 5pm at Judith H. Robbins Riverfront Park on Riverfront Drive in Attleboro MA, and will feature The Attleboro Arts Museum's Craft Fair & Art Sale, live bands and performances, glittering jewelry & precious metal exhibits, and food samplings by area restaurants and caterers.

The Attleboro Arts Museum invites all ARTISTS & CRAFTERS to participate in the Attleboro Arts Museum Craft Fair & Art Sale.

REQUIREMENTS:

- No kit crafts, imports, or commercially produced/manufactured items will be permitted. This fair supports artists and artisans in the sale of their own, original, handmade creations. Non-profit groups selling handmade items, which specifically promote their organization and its mission, can apply. Representatives of companies that produce merchandise for home parties and/or food vendors of any kind need not apply.
- Vendors are not permitted to sell items that are "inspired by" or derivative of products that have been created or manufactured by other vendors/businesses. Be sure that your entire line consists of your original, handmade creations that are conceived of, designed and produced by you.
- All proceeds from sales will remain with participating artists. The AAM will not be collecting a percentage of sales.
- Exhibitors are required to bring and set up all tables, tablecloths, chairs, shade cover tents, and supplies. All tables must be fully draped, and spaces should be clearly marked with the name of your business. We encourage creative outfitting of all booths and demonstrations of your painting, craft, etc. Tents will be placed on the lawn. *Of note: ALL tents are REQUIRED to have a minimum of 20lb weights safely attached to each leg (sand bags or water gallons are suggested as weights).*
- Electricity is NOT available.
- We want you to be successful. For crafters, please offer a range of price points, but do not exceed \$40. Please include at least one item that sells for \$5.00 or less. For artists, we suggest original art be priced no higher than \$60 per piece for an event of this kind.
- Exhibitors may apply for a booth individually – or as a team of no more than 2 crafters/artists.
- All exhibitors are expected to handle their own sales and to charge sales tax.
- To help promote traffic to your booth, all exhibitors are encouraged to provide a demonstration of how your work is created during either all or part of the Expo.

OUTDOOR EXPO SCHEDULE:

NEW Location: Judith H. Robbins Riverfront Park on Riverfront Drive in Attleboro MA (adjacent to the Attleboro Transit Center).

Travel: Specific directions will be provided due to Craft Fair/Art Sale detours & street closings.

Set up: 10:00am – 12:00pm

- **Please do not arrive early.** Set up CANNOT occur any earlier than 10am.

- A car pass to enter the event will be emailed to you. **Remember your car pass! ONE PASS PER EXHIBITOR.** Due to the volume of cars entering the event we cannot accommodate multiple vehicles per exhibitor. You will not be allowed to unload without this pass.

Fair open: 12:00 – 5:00pm

Load out: 5:00 – 6:00pm

- Exhibitors must be present and stocked during all Expo hours.
- Booths must be attended at all times. Please bring a colleague with you if you plan to take breaks.
- Exhibitors are responsible for unloading/setting up/taking down & packing up their booths.
- Exhibitors are not permitted to take down their booths before the Expo closes at 5:00pm. Attleboro Police will be directing the flow of traffic at the close of the event. Exhibitors must comply with Attleboro Police Department guidelines regarding times to pack up booths and travel out of the Expo.
- Booth grounds must be clean by 6:00pm.

TO APPLY:

Museum Hours: Tuesday – Saturday; 10am-5pm.

- Applications are due no later than **Saturday, May 12th, 2018 by 5pm.**
- Exhibitors will be informed of their acceptance via email by Saturday, May 19th, 2018.
- Once notified of acceptance, exhibitors must provide full booth payment by Thursday, May 31st by 5pm. If payment is not received when due, the exhibitor will forfeit his/her space at the fair. Please contact Abby Rovaldi at 508-222-2644 x15 or arovaldi@attleboroartsmuseum.org with any questions.
- **An active EMAIL address is required. If you do not have a personal email address, please supply the email of a family member, friend or colleague. EXPO Craft Fair & Art Sale communication will ONLY be sent out digitally.**

Your application and application fee must be accompanied by digital images (either on a USB flash drive or via email – no original artwork) of pieces that represent the items you plan to sell. Please email images to arovaldi@attleboroartsmuseum.org, subject line “EXPO 2018.” Images must be 300 dpi. Please do not only refer us to your website, you must send high resolution digital images (300 dpi or greater). This is required, even if you have been accepted to this fair in the past. Images that meet these specifications will be considered for use in EXPO promotional materials.

Due to the volume of entries, USB flash drives will not be returned.

This is a juried show. Acceptance is not guaranteed. Previous acceptance to Museum craft fairs will not guarantee acceptance to the 2018 Expo for the Senses Craft Fair & Art Sale.

Once notified of acceptance:

- Booth space: \$50.00 per 10ft x 10ft space for Museum Member; \$60.00 per 10ft x 10ft space for Non-members
- Double booth space, 20ft x 10ft (L x W): \$90.00 Member; \$110.00 Non-member

ATTENTION ALL CRAFTERS & ARTISTS:
