



How to Place Final Bids, Get the Auction Items that You've Won, See the Auction's Results – and More

Final Bidding Details

- The Auction will start to close one lot at a time (in numerical order) starting at 12pm, EST on Saturday, November 6th. The first Auction lot is #501. Our last lot is #728.
- Final bidding on each lot will last for one minute. Once bidding ends on a lot and a winner is determined the screen will advance to the next lot.
- If a lot receives bids during the final minute, the bidding time for that lot will automatically be extended by 10 minutes so that bidding can continue.
- In the meantime, the bidding on the remaining lots in the auction will progress one minute at a time.

Pick Up & Shipping

Winning bidders will be invoiced via email within one business day of the close of the Auction. Winners are required to pay their invoice prior to the release of their Auction item(s). In-person pick up of all auction items will take place at the Attleboro Arts Museum, beginning TUESDAY, November 9th at 10am EST, and run through SATURDAY, November 13th at 4pm EST. The Attleboro Arts Museum does not offer in-house packing or shipping services but can email you with a list of recommended carriers. Arrangements must be made within 5 business days. All shipping information can be found under "Auction Information" at the following link:

"Buy Now" Sale

(Formerly known as "Post-Auction" Sale)

If for *some* reason a lot has not found its new home by the end of the Auction, there will be a "BUY NOW" session that launches at 10am, EST on Thursday, November 11th and will run through Tuesday, November 16th at 5pm, EST.

The "BUY NOW" offering will appear exclusively online, **not in the Museum's gallery**, and therefore available 24/7. There's no back-and-forth bidding in "BUY NOW." Lots are sold for their opening bid and invoices will be issued via email by Wednesday, November 17th at 5pm, EST.

After paying an invoice, "BUY NOW" works can be picked up Tuesday, November 23rd or Wednesday, November 24th from 10am – 5pm, EST. You can also arrange to have work shipped. See above.

The "BUY NOW" session will include an option to donate outright to support maintenance of the Museum's permanent collection and fund art supplies and teaching materials for our art classes for all ages.
