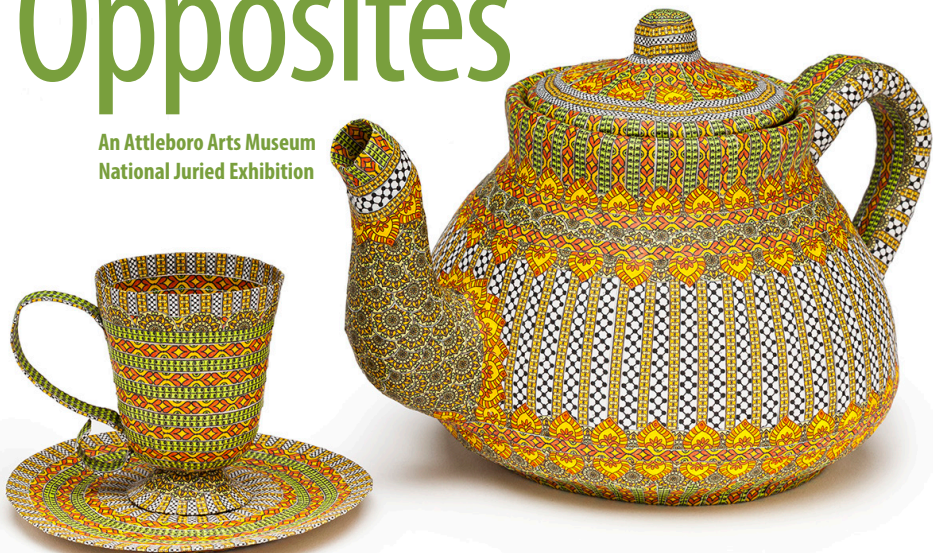

Functional objects in contemporary daily life are mostly mass produced, disposable and devoid of aesthetic value. The "non-functional functional objects" in Tarver's current series *Ten Paper Cups* are singular, meticulously designed and constructed by hand from paper and glue. Her series draws attention to the mundane things in daily life, to the functional/fine art dichotomy, and to the value of "stuff" in our throw-away society.
