

Team-building through **ART / WORK** at the Attleboro Arts Museum

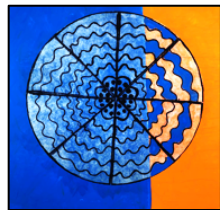
Book your group for a session of collaborative creativity!

The Attleboro Arts Museum offers specialized collaborative art-making sessions that include a private gallery tour for groups. Arts educator Sandy Coleman will lead groups through a three-hour workshop in which participants create individual ready-to-hang artworks that can be displayed on their own or combined as a whole to represent the significant creativity that individuals collectively bring. The workshops are geared toward team-building for businesses, organizations, schools and non-profits.

The Attleboro Arts Museum is happy to coordinate with each group on scheduling a team-building collaborative workshop. Visits will only be scheduled during times when exhibitions are on display in the Museum's main gallery. *Of note: team-building programs are subject to scheduling constraints due to Museum programs, exhibitions and events. Please contact us at least 3-4 weeks in advance for booking a workshop. An Attleboro Arts Museum staff member will contact you after the receipt of your request form to schedule a brief in-person meeting.*

Choose from one of the following projects (includes a brief gallery tour):

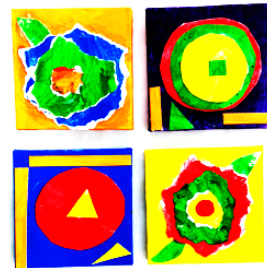
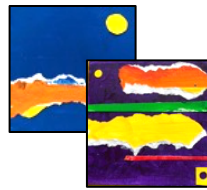
These group projects provide collaborative creativity while also encouraging individual expression. We are all working toward a common goal but we bring different imaginative elements to achieving the goals, which makes the end result unique yet connected.



Decorative Circles within a Square Project:

Participants will create one 10" x 10" mixed media painting on wood panel each. Play with color combinations, line and texture. Worried about a perfect circle?... don't be we're using simple templates. Everyone will leave with a ready-to-hang piece.

**Hanging instructions will be provided at the end of the workshop.*



Mini-Magnetic Canvas Collage Project:

Participants will create 2-4 unique 4" x 4" mini canvas collages. The beauty of these mini marvels is using the magnets so they can be rearranged and added on to. Depending on time, design 2 for the work place and 2 for home. Have endless fun with these modular masterpieces!
